

Ladies League at Crosswinds is all about fun! You must be registered to book a league tee time, but there are no registration fees, and no commitment to play every week. League days are Mondays and Wednesdays--pay & play whenever you can! Tee times are blocked off for Ladies League members only. Here are answers to more frequently asked questions about the Ladies League at Crosswinds:

HOW MUCH DOES LADIES LEAGUE COST?

9-Hole walking rate is \$38 (\$35 Spring rate till May 16). Optional cart is \$10 per rider. Rates are subject to HST.

WHAT IS THE STARTING TEE TIME FOR THE LADIES LEAGUE?

9-Hole tee times will generally be available starting at 3:30pm. Adjustments will be made to the starting time based on demand and seasonal variations.

WHEN CAN I BOOK A TEE TIME FOR LADIES LEAGUE?

Tee times will be available online from 1 week + a day starting at 9pm. (i.e., Sunday April 28 at 9pm, you will be able to book a tee time online to play on Monday May 6). Demand is very high early in the season, and as soon as tee times become available. Please be patient as we try our best to accommodate everyone by adding more times as necessary.

HOW DO I BOOK A TEE TIME ONLINE FOR LADIES LEAGUE?

You must be registered to book a league time. To register, email us at info@crosswindsgolf.com. Once you are registered:

- 1. Go to the Crosswinds website and click on 'Book a Tee Time'
- 2. Click 'League Players Enter Here'
- 3. Type in your Username and Password
- 4. Click 'Sign In'
- 5. Select the Ladies League you want to book into (if you are a member of other leagues, all will be listed)
- 6. Select the Date, Number of Holes, Number of Golfers
- 7. Click 'Next'
- 8. Select a Time from the League Tee Sheet
- 9. Select the Number of Carts
- 10. Type in the names of the other golfers in your group or select their name from your playing partners (optional)
- 11. Click 'Book Time'
- 12. Need help? Email us!

CAN I PHONE-IN TO BOOK A TEE TIME?

League tee times must be booked online only. Need help? Email us at info@crosswindsgolf.com.

I PLAYED IN THE LADIES LEAGUE LAST YEAR. AM I REGISTERED?

If you played in the Crosswinds Ladies League in the past 2 years, then yes, you are registered. If you are not sure when you last played or you forgot your username/password, email us.

CAN I PLAY 18-HOLES?

Ladies League members are welcome to book any available public 18-hole tee time on Mondays or Wednesdays (excluding holidays), however you must pay & play 18-holes. The Ladies League 18-hole rate is \$68 including cart (\$63 Spring rate until May 16). Rates are subject to HST. Keep in mind that if you are not booking a foursome, you may be paired up with other public golfers. Ladies playing 18-holes will not be able to participate in weekly on-course challenges.

IS THERE BE DINNER/INDOOR DINING AVAILABLE?

Our indoor dining is closed, as such, there is no dinner menu or year-end banquet. Our Back 9 Bistro serves grab & go snacks and beverages. Closing time will vary based on demand and seasonal variations (approx. 6/7pm closing time).

CAN I BRING A GUEST OR INVITE MY FRIEND TO JOIN?

Yes! However all guests must pre-register before playing. To register, email us at info@crosswindsgolf.com.

I AM A SINGLE GOLFER. ARE THERE ANY OPEN GROUPS THAT I CAN JOIN?

It is easy to see open available spots when you are booking a tee time online.

HOW LONG SHOULD IT TAKE TO PLAY 9-HOLES AT CROSSWINDS?

The set pace of play at Crosswinds is 2 hours 14 minutes to play the front 9 (Holes 1 to 9), and 2 hours 6 minutes to play the back 9 (Holes 10 to 18). Please keep this mind when you are playing.

WHAT TIME DOES THE COURSE CLOSE?

Our course closing time depends on the last tee time, but in general all golfers should be off the course by 8pm.
